## **Story Bridge Restoration project**

The current stage of works is now finished.

### End of current scope of works

Council has been undertaking restoration works between the Multicultural Centre and Captain Burke Park including abrasive blasting of all coatings, full new protective coating of steel and extensive concrete and steel repairs.

Council has now finished the current stage of works in this section. We would like to thank the community for their patience while this important work has been undertaken.

Council will continue its regular maintenance activities on the Story Bridge and hoarding and other equipment will remain in the vicinity of the bridge.

#### **Current completion activities**

- The airtight scaffolding encapsulation system, including the external white shrink wrap, air filtration system and scaffolding and other plant and equipment and on-site offices will be removed.
- Carparks including Council's Wharf Street Carpark will reopen.
- The site compound fencing will remain in Captain Burke Park to minimise costs for future restoration works.
- The load limits on the 2 outside traffic lanes on the bridge will remain.

#### **Project timing**

Most of these activities will be carried out in stages during the day, between 7am and 5pm, Monday to Friday. Some less impactful works may occur on Saturday between 7am and 4pm. Intermittent night works may be required from the overhead bridge road surface, between 8pm and 5am Sunday to Thursday. These activities will continue until late December 2024.


